and extending along said route(s) in a(n) Easterly direction to a point near 1/4 mile east  
Of Structure Number 100-3060

, a distance of approximately 1/2 miles; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the type of improvement shall be The rehabilitation of the Lake of Egypt Road  
Structure over the Lake of Egypt Spillway (SN 100-3060); deck replacement, structural steel work, painting, guardrail, etc.

and shall be designated as Section 13-00140-00-BR and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the improvement shall be constructed by Contract; and

On roll call vote **RESOLUTION NO. 14-03-11-36** passes the 11<sup>th</sup> day of March 11, 2014.


