
AGREED AMENDED ORDER FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

This case coming to before the Court on Williamson County Clerk Amanda Barnes' *Verified Complaint for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief* ("Verified Complaint"), the Court being fully advised in the premises, finds as follows:

1. On October 23, 2020, this matter came before the Court for hearing on the Williamson County Clerk Amanda Barnes' Emergency Notice of Presentment of her *Verified Complaint*.
2. After hearing, the Court granted the request for injunctive relief, allowing the Clerk to refrain from its practice of administering balloting on site at Williamson County nursing homes as listed in Exhibit A of the *Verified Complaint*. The Court entered this order on October 23, 2020.
3. This matter is again coming before this Court to address the Clerk's statutory obligations under 10 ILCS 5/19-12.2 in regards to voting by physically incapacitated electors as described by that statute.
4. Because the Clerk, as a result of this Court's October 23, 2020 order, is relieved of her obligation to conduct on-site balloting at the Williamson County nursing homes listed in Exhibit A of the *Verified Complaint*, an alternative voting procedure is necessary to preserve the right to vote of the residents of these facilities. If an alternative to on-premises voting is not established, the voters of the affected facilities will suffer irreparable harm to their clearly ascertainable right to vote, with no adequate remedy at law.

Based upon the foregoing findings, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. On October 30, 2020, the Williamson County Clerk, through her authorized agents, shall deliver the ballots and ballot envelopes to the residents of the nursing homes who have requested them rather than conduct on premises voting as required by 19-12.2 of the Election Code.
2. The administrator of each affected facility will be instructed to provide these ballots and ballot envelopes to voters in their facilities. The administrator of the affected facility will sign a certification that the ballot was provided to the voter, who was allowed to vote the ballot in private, and that, upon completion of the voting, the ballot was sealed in the provided ballot envelope prior to being received by the facility administrator. In the event that the voter requested assistance, the normal certification of assistance to a voter would be completed by the person chosen by the voter to assist them and this certification would be returned along with the ballot in the ballot envelope.
3. No later than November 2, 2020, the Clerk, or her authorized agent, shall collect from each administrator of the affected facilities all sealed ballot envelopes and certifications.
4. All ballots cast pursuant to this Order will be held for tabulation until after the polls close on November 3, 2020.
5. A copy of the *Verified Complaint* and this *Agreed Amended Temporary Restraining Order* will be posted on the Williamson County Clerk's website through November 5, 2020.
