

HEAD MECHANIC POSITION

The Williamson County Highway Department is accepting applications for a head mechanic position. This position will report to the County Engineer. Preferred candidates should have a CDL driver's license and at least 5 years mechanic experience pertaining to heavy equipment, diesel engine, and/or automotive repair and service, an automotive related college degree or 60 hours of coursework associated with heavy equipment, diesel, and automotive repair and/or certifications from Automotive Service Excellence (ASE). The college coursework or certifications shall be comprised of classes in diesel mechanics, internal combustion engines, engine electrical, diagnostic equipment, transmissions, a/c systems, hydraulic systems and general preventive maintenance. Both shop and field repairs will be required.

Beginning salary will be \$30.40 per hour with benefits. Williamson County offers a competitive package of benefits including IMRF retirement, sick, personal, and vacation days, paid holidays, head clothing, tools provided and annual clothing allowance. Williamson County maintains 660 miles of roads and 99 bridges utilizing over 100 pieces of equipment varying from standard passenger vehicles, wheeled excavator, motor graders, farm tractors, bushhogs, backhoes, tandem dump trucks, concrete saws, bobcats, and wheeled loaders.
